I. OBJECTIVES

The Chemical Industries Council of Malaysia (CICM) is a formal association registered under the Companies Act 1965 as a company limited by guarantee. The main objectives of CICM are as follows:-

- (a) To coordinate the efforts by the chemical industries for the benefit of Malaysia as well as for intra-ASEAN regional economies.
- (b) To undertake, coordinate, or encourage the conduct of research and studies which will serve to identify opportunities for projects on products for complementation in the chemical industries.
- (c) To develop and initiate the preparation and implementation of plans, programs and projects that will promote and advance local and intra-ASEAN trade of chemical products.
- (d) To formulate and develop recommendation towards rationalization of government rules and regulations on shipping, banking, documentation, investment incentives, tariff and non-tariffs benefits, and other measures for identified projects and products for complementation.
- (e) To establish a system for the prompt compilation and dissemination of statistical and other data in support of the promotion and coordination of the chemical industry in Malaysia and other ASEAN-Chemical Industries Council members.
- (f) To initiate, encourage and coordinate efforts that will assist the members of the chemical industry in examining the present and future trends in Malaysia and intra-ASEAN region.
- (g) To provide effective procedural measures for the establishment of an institutional identity to promote the interest of the members in dealing with :-
 - government
 - other private sectors, institutions and industries; and
 - the public in general, within Malaysia, intra-ASEAN and outside the ASEAN region as may be considered desirable by the Directors.
- (h) To affiliate itself to the ASEAN-Chemical Industries Council members and serve as the recognised representative from the private sector in Malaysia to implement and deal with problems with ASEAN coordination in the chemical industry.
- (i) To promote the chemical industry as an instrument of economic development for the region.

II. MEMBERSHIP

Membership in CICM is opened to those who are in the chemical industry. There are two types of membership; full and associate membership. Full membership is opened to companies who are chemical manufacturers in Malaysia. Associate membership is opened to companies engaged in trading, consultancy, providing services to the chemical industry in Malaysia.
